On Feb 16th at our evening service we had a wonderful service. No, it wasn't because of the pastor's sermon. It was because a large gathering of Christians came together to hear a missionary speak about his work in Africa.

The missionary was Clint Lyles, age 14 who spoke of his trip to Africa with Ronnie Owens earlier this month. It was a great report by a young man who felt called by God to put feet to his prayers and obedience to his commitment to follow Jesus a year earlier.

For many Christians, the word evangelism simply means getting people to walk to the front of the church and become a member. Evangelism at its heart is to "become more like Jesus." That means evangelism is something you are, not what you say or do. It's what happens in the context of building discipleship relationships. When we are willing to "consume" Jesus on the inside instead of wearing Christianity on the outside, we grow in Christ, in discipleship and building relationships in Christ's name.

What Clint displayed is a willingness to allow his faith to challenge inexperience, fear of the unknown, and "nay sayers" who might suggest such a mission is impossible and impractical. You'll need to ask Clint about his possible betrothal while there making disciples.

I wonder how Paul felt when God called him to "go make disciples?"

Several years ago, The U.S. Center of World Missions reported that in 30 A.D., when the church was just getting started, there were 200 million people in the world & only about 5,000 Christians. That is a ratio of 40,000x1.

By the year 1900, there were a billion people in the world & 10 million committed Christians. That's a ratio of 100x1. Christianity Today reports today's population is 7.2 billion people and 2.18 billion Christians and that's a ratio of 3x1.

Wouldn't it be wonderful if we could claim that Jesus' work in the world has significantly changed our world and that now after nearly 2000 years, our world is honestly $1/3^{rd}$ Christian.

Math is not my strong suit, in fact I'm not sure what my strong suit is but fear and trembling surely come to mind. But I do know that as God revealed his vision for Christians in the book of Acts, there are significant lessons learned that apply to us today and as experienced in the life of a young missionary named Clint.

First, Acts 8:4 says "those who had been scattered preached the word wherever they went." The whole world started changing because wherever they went they told others about Jesus. Ok, so persecution motivated them to leave home but God is in the business of getting His Word out, with or without our willingness.

Today, people are constantly being moved. School, work, church, missions trips all revolve around people being scattered physically and emotionally. What if we began a movement to preach, teach, make disciples wherever we find ourselves. Would it not change Claiborne County? I don't mean simply inviting people to church. I mean a mission where we get involved in the life and culture of real people in such a way that they might know who Jesus is and what believing Him means.

Secondly, like Paul in 1 Cor 16:5-9 and Clint in Africa, we might embrace the missionary spirit of discipleship that says "I will come to you" in love, compassion and grace. God leaves no one out when he calls us to follow him and He opens the Door of Opportunity all around us.

Thirdly, Paul said "I" will come and Clint said "I" will go. When the door of opportunity is open, it is immediately followed by a Door of Obligation. I can't do your work for you & you can't do my work for me. Paul and Clint were ready to respond.


Finally, when you open the doors of Opportunity and Obligation, expect to discover the Door of Opposition. Clint has only begun his walk of faith. There will be many hindrances, setbacks, and mistakes in the years ahead. Paul experienced them and so will you and I but oh the joy of one day seeing Jesus face to face and hearing His words, "this is my beloved disciple" who ran the race with all his "heart, soul and mind."

Thank you Clint for sharing your life of faith with the people of Africa and your story of adventure in faith with us your church family. May we all be faithful as we Connect To God, Family and Community!


